#### VILLAGE OF MIDWAY

### BYLAW NO. 287

A Bylaw to Provide for Council Member Remuneration and Expenses

The Council of the Village of Midway in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

# REMUNERATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS

- 1. (a) The annual remuneration for the Mayor for the discharge  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{M}}$ 
  - of the duties of office is FOUR THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$4,200.00).
- 2. (b) The annual remuneration for a Councillor for the discharge of the duties of office is THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00).

#### **INCIDENTAL EXPENSES**

2. A portion of the remuneration for a member of Council set out in section 1, being ONE THIRD (1/3), is an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office, other than expenses covered under sections 3 or 4.

# **EXPENSES INCURRED**

3. (Registration fees and travel expenses of spouses are deemed as expenses incurred by the Councillor while attending a meeting, course or convention)

Within one week of delivery by a Council member to the Treasurer of written evidence of expenditures made or expenses incurred when the council member is:

- (a) representing the Municipality beyond its boundaries;
- (b) engaging in municipal business beyond the Municipality's boundaries; or
- (c) attending a course or convention,

the Treasurer shall pay to the Council member the amount of the expenditures made or expenses incurred.

# QUALIFYING EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES

- 4. (a) The types of expenses and expenditures that may qualify for payment under section 3 are:
  - (i) hotels;
  - (ii) transportation other than by way of the Council

member's own motor vehicle;

- transportation by way of the Council member's (iii) own motor vehicle;
- telephone or facsimile transmission;
- (V) photocopying;
- meals; (vi)
- (vii) gratuities

# LEVELS OF PAYMENT

(a) The level at which the Treasurer shall reimburse a 5. Council member for transportation by way of the council member's own motor vehicle is \$0.50 per mile.

#### REPEAL

"Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 189 (1989) is repealed.

#### CITATION

This bylaw may be cited as "Remuneration and Expenses 7. Bylaw No. 287, 1997.
