
Council News

- The 2016 Annual Report was accepted by Council.
- Council approved the two-year lease agreement for the Midway Medical Centre and the doctor.
- Council approved the land lease agreement for part of the Midway Airport Lands being used for farming purposes.
- Nominations are now being reviewed by Council for the 2017 Volunteer of the Year, which will be presented at the Volunteer Appreciation Day BBQ on Saturday, September 9, 2017 at the gazebo in the Riverfront Park.
- The October 2, 2017 Regular Council Meeting has been cancelled because of a staff shortage in the front office, and Council being away at the UBCM convention.

Be Bear Aware - Bear season is approaching. Please be cautious and aware when you are out walking in the Village, on the trails, or in your yard. To prevent bears from entering your property it is important to put garbage & green bins away nightly, cover compost piles, clean BBQs, and to remove fruit from and around all fruit trees.



Burning Ban - It has come to our attention that some residents are burning household waste and garbage, which is strictly prohibited in any burning incinerator at anytime. Residents are also reminded that all types of burning (campfire, open, fireworks, etc.) are strictly prohibited within the Village of Midway. These restrictions will remain in place until the public is otherwise notified. **All previously issued burn permits are now null and void until further notice.** The prohibition does not apply to cooking stoves that use gas, propane or briquettes, or to portable campfire apparatus with a CSA or ULC rating that uses briquettes, liquid or gaseous fuel, so long as the height of the flame is less than 15 cm. The use of a campfire apparatus that does not meet these specifications is prohibited.

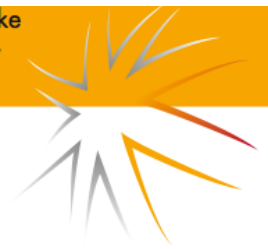

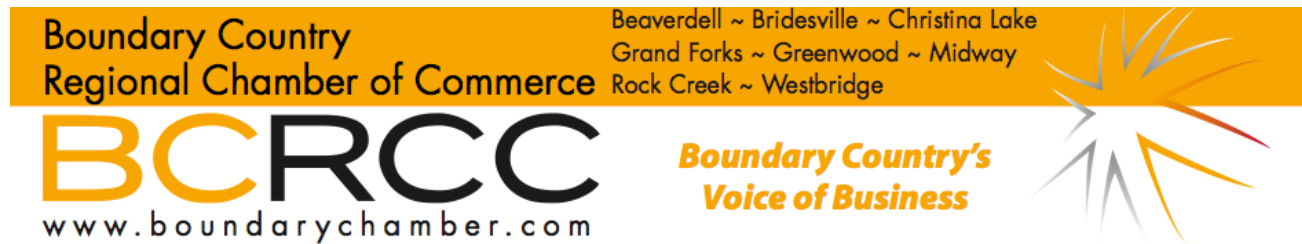
