RDKB Recycling Bins - Council received notice that the RDKB is considering removing the recycling bins from Midway located by the arena because too many contaminated items are being brought to the bins. A public meeting will be scheduled in the new year and residents are highly encouraged to attend and voice their opinion on the importance of keeping the recycling bins in Midway. Residents are asked to please respect the RDKB Recycling Bins and surrounding area located by the arena. The bins are for **RECYCLING ONLY** please do not leave garbage, old paint, furniture, clothing, toys, etc. beside the bins for someone else to clean up. We do not want to increase the risk of losing these recycling bins by leaving contaminated and prohibited items in and around the bins.

Water-well Licencing - Amendments have been made to the Provincial Water Sustainability Act to include extending the groundwater licence application fee waiver period from December 31 2017 to March 1, 2019. This extended date also aligns with the March 1, 2019 deadline for existing groundwater users to apply for a licence.

January 2018 Regular Council Meetings - Please note that for the month of January 2018 the regular meetings of Council are scheduled for the second and fourth Monday of the month on January 8 and January 22. All other 2018 Regular Council meetings will remain on the first and third Mondays of each month unless it falls on a stat holiday or is otherwise posted.

Dog Tags - 2018 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash or cheque only until the new year. *Please note: cheques will not be processed until the new year.*

Midway Community Garden - Anyone wishing to reserve their current garden plot at the Midway Community Garden for the 2018 growing season is encouraged to stop by the office as soon as possible. Gardeners who currently rent a plot will have until December 29, 2017 to reserve the same plot for next year. After this date all un-claimed garden plots, regardless of whether something has been planted in said plot, will become available to the public on a first-come-first-serve basis. Please note we will not be accepting payment at this time.

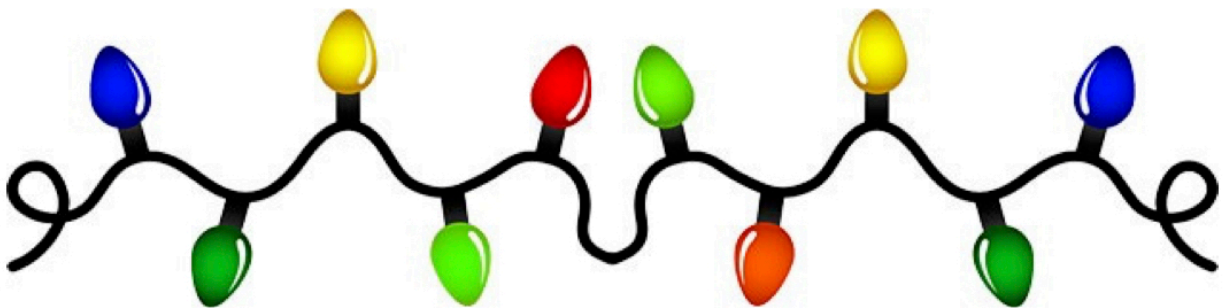
