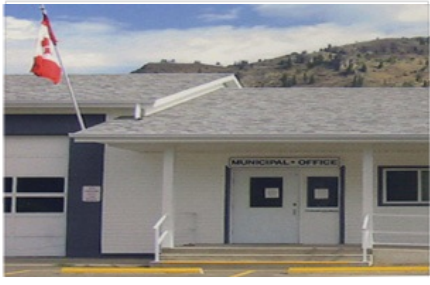
## Village of Midway office will be closed Monday February 12, 2018 for BC Family Day
