## ICBC & Motor Vehicles

The Village of Midway Office offers all of your ICBC Autoplan and Drivers Services needs. **Dog Tags** - 2018 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash, cheque or debit.

Dog owners are reminded to ensure dogs do not bark constantly during the day and night as it is a disturbance to the public and neighbours.

**Fire Permits** - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for all burning within the Village and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office. This includes campfire, and open burn piles not exceeding one metre in height and one metre in width. <u>No person shall ignite or</u> cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste.

\*\*\*Please note that there are <u>Open Burn</u> restrictions: there will be no open burning allowed during the peak hours of 11:00 am and 6:00 pm. <u>This restriction applies</u> to all new and previously issued burn permits.\*\*\*

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

## **Council Meeting News**

• Council approved with MFLNRM and Rural Development GeoBC for the term 2018-2020 a Data Sharing and Licensing Agreement for the GeoBC Atlas Integrated Transportation Network. This dataset is utilized by ECOMM 911, BC Ambulance, RCMP as well as some fire systems in the Province for first responder dispatching and is important to ensure that what the Province is distributing to these agencies agrees with local government center line road information.


• <u>The Community Emergency Preparedness Fund</u> (CEPF) is a suite of funding programs intended to enhance the resiliency of local governments and their residents in responding to emergencies. The Village will be applying for funding under the Flood Risk Assessment, Flood Mapping & Flood Mitigation Planning stream and have requested RFP's. As of the March 21<sup>st</sup> deadline, the Village received 6 proposals, these will be reviewed and evaluated over the next couple of weeks and will be brought forward to Council for their review, and decision.

• <u>Kettle Valley Express</u> – Copies of the 2018 Kettle Valley Express are available at different locations throughout the boundary area. This year the Province (Recreation Sites and Trails BC) created a map showing the KVR Trail and is included as an insertion in the guide.

• <u>EV Charging Station</u> – The Community Energy Association is working with the Village on the placement of another EV Charging Station in Midway. They have potentially found a funding partner to share installation costs and are setting up a meeting between the Village of Midway, CEA and the potential funding partner to consider a suitable site.

• <u>Legacy Fund Application</u> - Midway Community Centre Retrofit project – Some members of Council will meet with the MCA Board on April 9, 2018 at 7:30 pm at the Midway Community Centre to discuss further, the partnering requirements of the grant application. This will include discussions surrounding the possibility of setting up a Memorandum of Understanding between the Village of Midway and the MCA and details that will outline potential duties for both parties.

• <u>Kettle River Museum Society</u> – The Council gave formal approval for the KRMS to operate the museum bunkhouse as a hostel which will accommodate the KVR Trail users.
