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4b) Council discussed with Public Works Foreman the Boundary Creek sewer line crossing. PW Foreman requires an engineer to look at the crossing to advise and recommend what action need to be taken. Each year the high water exposes more of the sewer line increasing the risk and likelihood that it will become damaged. After further discussion it was:

RMS Risk Management Services will undertake a review of the Village's current policies, directives and procedures for adequateness, and will perform a review of the Village's operations (Public Works and Infrastructure), and they will draft a manual of risk management policies, directives and procedures to match exposures and the resources available to mitigate the risks identified.
