Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for all burning within the Village and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office. At this time, **Campfires only**. No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste.

***Please note that there is currently a ban on <u>Open</u> <u>Burns. This restriction applies to all new and</u> <u>previously issued burn permits.</u> ***

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

Yards and Vacant Lot Mowing - Given the ongoing forest fire risk in our area, this is a reminder that we need to take precautions by ensuring yards and vacant lots are mowed on a regular basis. With the onset of another hot dry season, we need to continue towards minimizing potential risk to our community and would appreciate your assistance in helping to prevent your property from becoming a recognizable fire hazard.

Dog Tags - 2018 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash, cheque or debit.

Dog owners are reminded to ensure dogs do not bark constantly during the day and night as it is a disturbance to the public and neighbours. Also, please pick up and discard dog waste in garbage receptacles.

As the weather continues to get hotter, please do not discard any cigarette butts if you are enjoying any of our walking or hiking trails

Water Usage and Restrictions - Residents are reminded that watering restrictions are always in effect per Bylaw No. 413 and that sprinkling (irrigating) lawns and gardens between the hours of 10:00 am and 6:00 pm is prohibited. There is plenty of time to establish a green lawn. The Village of Midway reserves the right to disconnect offenders from the water service for violation of regulations and wasteful use of water. Any service that has been disconnected will be charged a minimum of \$50.00 before service resumes. On your own well? Remember that all Village water comes from the same aquifer and your use also contributes to the lower water levels even if you don't think it does. We appreciate your cooperation.

<u>Tree Recycling Facility</u> - The only acceptable materials are **GRASS CLIPPINGS**, **NOXIOUS WEEDS** AND TREE BRANCHES. This is not a landfill. Unacceptable materials are being dropped off at the Tree Recycling Facility. These materials must be removed by Public Works staff before chipping of approved materials. Damage to the chipper will be paid by the Village and result in increased access fees, or continued disregard for the accepted materials will result in closure of the facility.
