Public Meeting Notice - On Saturday November 17, 2018 10am at the McArthur Centre in Greenwood, there will be an opportunity to learn about the BC's Electoral Reform Referendum Vote. Linda Larson, MLA for Boundary-Similkameen and Michael Lee, MLA for Vancouver-Langara and Official Opposition Critic for the Attorney General will be speaking at the event.

Kettle River Museum AGM - Tuesday November 13, 2018 at 2pm in the Bunkhouse. Residents are welcome to come meet the Board and learn what is happening out at the Museum.

Plowing and Boulevards - In preparation for the upcoming snow removal season, residents are reminded to **keep all boulevards clear of vehicles and other obstructions** to ensure Public Works can effectively remove snow in a timely matter. This includes rocks and other objects that can freeze to the ground potentially causing damage to Municipal equipment.

Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that a valid burn permit is required for all camp fires and open burns within the Village of Midway. Open fires are restricted to no larger than 1 metre by 1 metre and are for the burning of dry garden and lawn waste, slash, or other organic materials only.

PLEASE NOTE: The burning of slash, garden waste and grass is prohibited in a campfire. Additionally, the burning of household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, styrofoam, industrial/commercial waste, and other products is prohibited in a campfire pit AND open fires.

Anyone caught burning prohibited materials in camp fires or Category 2 Open Fires will be fined a minimum of \$500 per Bylaw #451
