Discussion

a) <u>Kettle Valley Racing Association – Snowmobile Drag Races</u> – <u>Moved</u> Councillor Dunsdon, <u>Seconded</u> Councillor Schierbeck to approve Kettle Valley Racing Association's request to use the airport property to host the 10th annual snowmobile drag races February 2, 2019, as well as the use of the Village generator to supply power to the concession stand. <u>Carried</u> Mayor Fromme would like staff to look at the license to occupy agreement to make sure it covers all licences required to host an event including if there is food.

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b) <u>Preliminary Budget Planning</u> – Councillor Dunsdon does not want to use any of the Community Forest monies for Village day to day bills. These are special monies that should be set aside for things that might come up unexpectedly. The rest of Council agreed.
