Fire Permits - Open burns are once again allowed within the Village of Midway boundaries.

***Please note that there are Open Burn restrictions: there will be no open burning allowed during the peak hours of 11:00 am and 6:00 pm.

This restriction applies to all new and previously issued burn permits.***

Residents are reminded that burning permits for all fires are required within the Village and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste under any circumstances.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

Airport Hangar Space Rentals - Space in the airport hangar is available to rent for vehicles/ trailers/RVS. For trailers this includes the length of the trailer plus the length of the hitch. Rental space is available on a first-come first-served basis. Please call the Village Office for more information on rental rates and availability at 250-449-2222. Renters are required to have a minimum of \$2 million liability insurance on the unit.
