Hunting - Residents are reminded that hunting within the boundaries of the Village of Midway is strictly prohibited as per the Discharge of Firearms Regulation Bylaw 207 and amending Bylaw 462. More information regarding the bylaws can be found on our website: www.midwaybc.ca/bylaws-policies/

Plowing and Boulevards - In preparation for the upcoming snow removal season, residents are reminded to **keep all boulevards clear of vehicles and other obstructions** to ensure Public Works can effectively remove snow in a timely matter. This includes rocks and other objects that can freeze to the ground potentially causing damage to Municipal equipment.

Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits for all fires are required within the Village and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

*****Please note that there are Open Burn restrictions: there will be no open burning allowed during the peak hours of 11:00 am and 6:00 pm. This restriction applies to all new and previously issued burn permits.*****

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste under any circumstances.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).
