

Q1 What is your age?


Q2 What is your gender?

Q3 What type of housing do you anticipate needing in the future as you age in Midway? (select any that apply)






Q7 I am able to comfortably get around Midway without the use of a private automobile. (select the extent to which you agree or not)






Q12 Are you a member of any voluntary organizations or associations, such as school groups, church social groups, community centres, ethnic associations or social, civic or fraternal clubs?







Q13 How often did you participate in meetings or activities of these groups in the past 12 months? If you belong to many, just think of the ones in which you are most active.





Q15 I have enough 'say' in local government decisions that affect my life. (select the extent to which you agree or not)








Q20 What are the most age friendly aspects of living in Midway? (choose your top 3)
