ICBC & Motor Vehicles

The Village of Midway Office offers all of your ICBC Autoplan and Drivers Services needs.

Tree Recycling Facility - Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic it has been decided that there will be no charge for the use of the tree recycling facility for the 2020 year by Midway residents. Please be advised that all rules for using the facility are still the same. Yard and garden waste only no building materials or garbage allowed. If these rules are not adhered to the facility will be closed to all users. Council and staff are also asking for all residents to observe social distancing practices while using the tree recycling facility.

Village Office - Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic the Village of Midway Office is closed until further notice to keep front line workers safe during this time. ICBC transactions are being processed electronically. If you would like to conduct your ICBC transactions with the Village please call 250-449-2222 and staff will guide you through the process. 2020 TAXES - The Village Office has acquired a wireless debit machine to continue to operate and maintain services while ensuring the health, safety and economic well being of our residents. Cheques and debit transactions are the preferred method of payment but cash will be accepted. Credit cards are not accepted. Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that all burning is prohibited within the boundaries of The Village of Midway. Only CAS-approved or ULC-approved portable campfire apparatus may be used for the purpose of heating, cooking and ceremonial purposes and the flame length must not exceed 15 centimetres.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

Dog Tags - 2020 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash, cheque or debit.

2020 Business Licences - The \$50 annual fee was due in January for businesses operating in the Village of Midway. Fees can be paid at the Village Office by cash, cheque or debit.
