Tree Recycling Facility - Due to the COVID-19

If these rules are not adhered to the facility will be closed to all users. Council and staff are also asking for all residents to observe social distancing practices while using the tree recycling facility.

Airport Lands - Residents are reminded that for liability reasons there is no walking permitted on the airstrip, or vehicles unless permission is received. This is an active airstrip and the Village is concerned for safety of the public and those who are flying planes.

<u>Council Meetings</u> - During these times of social distancing Council meetings will now be held in the Midway Community Centre to accommodate a 6 foot buffer between Council, staff and residents.

Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for all burning within the Village and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office. No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

Please note that Open Burns are not allowed.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

Village Office - Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic the Village of Midway Office doors are still closed until further notice to keep front line workers safe during this time. However staff is still conducting ICBC transactions. These are being processed electronically. If you would like conduct your ICBC transactions with the Village please call 250-449-2222 and staff will guide you through the process.
