Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for campfires within the Village of Midway and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

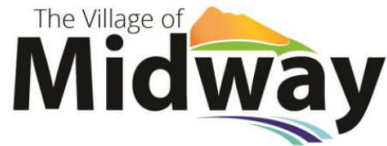
Category 2 and 3 fires are still prohibited within the boundaries of the Village of Midway until further notice.

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

******Please note that Open Burns are not allowed.******

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

Responsible Pet Owners - Pet owners are reminded they are responsible for their pet's excrement as per Bylaw 438 Part 7. **Pet owners are also asked to consider other users of public spaces. While out in public and on hiking and walking trails, please ensure you are in control of your pet at all times.**
