Commercial Property Taxes - If you own commercial property in the Village of Midway, this is a reminder that your property taxes are due on September 30, 2020. Any outstanding balances will incur a 10% penalty on October 1, 2020. If you wish to pay in person, you may do so at the Village Office with cash, cheque or debit. You may also mail a cheque, but post marks will not be accepted. We must receive your payment by September 30, 2020.

If you do not have access to the online version, please contact the Village Office for a hard copy. <u>Fire Permits</u> - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for <u>campfires</u> within the Village of Midway and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

Camp fires must be supervised until it is completely extinguished! This means no walking away to let the fire smoulder until it's out.

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

Please note that Open Burns are not allowed.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

Level 2 Drought Conditions - The Province has elevated the drought level in the Kettle and East Kootenay drought polygons to Level 2, due to prolonged dry conditions and low river flows. This is the first time this year that the drought level has been elevated in these areas. While snowpack was near normal, melt happened late and was accompanied by fairly wet weather in May and June. The hot and dry weather of July and August has only now resulted in streamflow falling noticeably below normal for the time of year. Please be conscious of your water conservation habits to ensure we aren't contributing to the drought conditions.
