# Village of Midway – Boundary Expo Recreation Centre (BERC) Public Skating & Stick and Puck Procedures

Updated: November 18, 2020

#### Introduction

In order to run the safest program possible, we have implemented the following guidelines. All regulations and guidelines are in alignment with WorkSafeBC, VIA Sport and the BC Provincial Government. Failure to adhere to the regulations and guidelines will result in removal of said person(s). It is important that all individuals understand by choosing to participate in physical activities outside the home during the pandemic, you are at an increased risk of contracting COVID-19. This is an inherent risk of participating in non-essential activities in your community.

#### Health

Anyone experiencing symptoms of illness will not be permitted to enter the facility. Please stay at home if you are feeling ill, have travelling outside of Canada or have been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days, or have been directed to self-isolate. We ask that you practice safe hand hygiene, use hand sanitizer and wash your hands frequently. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building. Facemasks are not mandatory; however, they are strongly recommended. If you cannot maintain a 2m physical distance, wear a mask.

# **Facility Protocols**

### Arrival, Sign In & Exit

- Please arrive no sooner than 15min before the program start time
- The designated entrance to the BERC is located at the north end of the building (main entrance)
- Sign in upon entry and sanitize your hands
- There will be chairs in the lobby where you can sit and put on your skates
  - o also, the lower section of the stands
  - o if necessary, dressing rooms 5 & 6 will be opened
- Minimal skate rentals will be available at this time
- Upon completion of your skate, promptly exit the facility
  - All participants must exit within 15min of the scheduled program completion
- · Socializing and gathering is not permitting in the facility

### **Program Details**

- Open Public Skate & Stick and Puck reservations are available to participants of all ages
- The maximum capacity is 25 participants
- Adults supervising children are responsible for monitoring and enforcing appropriate behaviour and physical distancing (2m) while in the facility
- CSA helmets are not mandatory but strongly recommended
  - o CSA helmets and protective gloves are mandatory for Stick and Puck
- The use of player benches and penalty boxes is prohibited
- NO SPITTING!

#### **Building Use**

Washrooms are available. We ask you to adhere to all posted physical distancing and capacity signs and strongly recommend wearing a mask while moving throughout the building.

### Illness Plan

If you become ill during your registered activity, please inform staff. You will be asked to leave immediately and to contact Interior Health at 8-1-1.

Patrons are reminded that physical distancing is each person's responsibility. If you are uncomfortable in any space, you may wear a mask, face shield, step away or remove yourself from the activity.

Village of Midway Staff reserve the right to refuse service and withdraw any participant who is not following the above guidelines, the proposed safety plan and facility guidelines. The Village of Midway encourages and promotes the use of masks while on site.

Arena Staff have increased the sanitation of the facility.
