Fireworks - As per Bylaw #451, Part 4, Sec. 24, No person shall possess Fireworks for purposes of use, or use, set off, explode or discharge Fireworks. As per Sec 26 (1), Sec 24 does not apply if a person has received a permit from the Council to use, set off, explode or discharge Fireworks, for religious ceremonial, celebratory or business related purposes. If you do receive a permit, please be courteous to those around you by notifying them. Full details of Bylaw #451 can be found on our website.

<u>Water Restrictions</u> - All residents are reminded that irrigating your lawn or garden is prohibited from

10AM to 6PM EVERY DAY.

Dog Tags - 2021 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash, cheque and debit are accepted.

Vacant property mowing - Residents are reminded to have their properties grass kept below 20 centimetres as per property maintenance and standards Bylaw No. 525, 2020.

Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for all burning within the Village and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office. This includes campfire, and open burn piles not exceeding one metre in height and one metre in width. <u>No person</u> <u>shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste,</u> <u>refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam,</u> <u>industrial or commercial waste</u>.

Please note that there are Open Burn restrictions: there will be no open burning allowed during the peak hours of 11:00 am and 6:00 pm. <u>This restriction applies</u> to all new and previously issued burn permits.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).
