Slippery roads, parking lots, and sidewalks -

Please be cautious when walking in the Village as roads, sidewalks, and parking lots may be icy, especially after a fresh snowfall. Take precautions and wear appropriate foot wear when out enjoying the fresh air.



Plowing and Boulevards - Residents are reminded to keep all boulevards clear of vehicles and other obstructions to ensure Public Works can effectively remove snow in a timely matter. This includes rocks and other objects that can freeze to the ground potentially causing damage to Municipal equipment.

Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for campfires within the Village of Midway and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

Camp fires must be supervised until it is completely extinguished! **This means no walking away to let the fire smoulder until it's out.**

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

******Please note that Open Burns are one again permitted but Category 3 fires are prohibited.******

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

Responsible Pet Owners - Pet owners are reminded they are responsible for their pet's excrement as per Bylaw 438 Part 7.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARE IN CONTROL OF YOUR PET AT ALL TIMES AND THEY REMAIN LEASHED WHILE IN THE VILLAGE OF MIDWAY.
