<u>Dog Tags</u> - 2022 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash, cheque and debit are accepted.

Midway Community Garden - Any gardeners from 2021 are encouraged to call or come to the office to reserve their plots or raised beds for the 2022 season. There are lots of unclaimed spaces available that are up for grabs.

Feeding Deer and Wildlife - Residents are reminded to not feed deer and other wildlife within the Village of Midway. The Conservation Officer encourages everyone to remember that deer have an ample food supply in the wild, and supplementing this natural food supply not only attracts and holds deer in the community but can trigger an unsustainable population increase, and can also attract other predators into the community.

Utility Billing - We have issued the Water and Sewer Utility billing for 2022. Please remember, like property taxes, these are not due until July 4, 2022, after then a 10% penalty will be applied to any unpaid balance. Everyone is welcome to pay at their convenience to avoid having to pay both at the same time. Property Tax notices should be issued in May.

2022 Business Licences - The \$50 annual fee is due in January for businesses operating in the Village of Midway. Fees can be paid at the Village Office by cash, cheque or debit.

Slippery roads, parking lots, and sidewalks -

Please be cautious when walking in the Village as roads, sidewalks, and parking lots may be icy, especially after a fresh snowfall. Take precautions and wear appropriate foot wear when out enjoying the fresh air.



Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for <u>campfires</u> within the Village of Midway and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

Camp fires must be supervised until it is completely extinguished! This means no walking away to let the fire smoulder until it's out.

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

Please note that Open Burns are permitted but Category 3 fires are prohibited.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).
