Fire Permits - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for <u>campfires</u> within the Village of Midway and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

<u>Camp fires must be supervised until it is</u> <u>completely extinguished!</u> This means no walking away to let the fire smoulder until it's out.

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

Please note that Open Burns are permitted but Category 3 fires are prohibited.

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).



Midway Public Library seeks Trustees

Midway Public Library serves the citizens of Midway and Area E. In addition to our own collection and access to books from all BC Libraries we offer: public computers and printing; office services such as photocopying and faxing; programming for children and adults such as Lego club, story time, book clubs, creators' club, summer reading club, reading challenges and contests. The library has a part time staff of three: Library Director and two Assistants.

The library is an incorporated Library Association under the Library Act and a registered charity. As such we require a committed board of trustees. The role of trustee is to oversee policy and finance and support the Library Director who manages day to day operations. Knowledge of the library world is not a requirement. There are workshops, information sharing sessions and access to individual supports through the B.C. Library Trustees Association and the Kootenay Library Federation. A background in business or the not for profit sector is helpful but not necessary.. What is really required is a belief in the importance of libraries and a willingness to learn and participate in governance. We would especially like to hear from younger members of the community.

Our particular asks would be for people to be involved with employee relations and policy development, and someone who could <u>identify</u> maintenance issues, and assist with special projects and small tasks (the Village takes care of the building)

The Association meets six times a year and meetings are about one and half hours. Participation in committees such as policy development would require extra time. In addition there may be two or three fundraising events (COVID permitting.)

Please consider involvement with the Midway Public Library. Libraries are an important part of a vibrant community but they can only exist with the help of dedicated volunteers.
