**Dog Tags** - 2022 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash, cheque and debit are accepted.

**2022 Business Licences** - The \$50 annual fee is due in January for businesses operating in the Village of Midway. Fees can be paid at the Village Office by cash, cheque or debit.

**Fire Permits** - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for campfires within the Village of Midway and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

**Camp fires must be supervised until it is completely extinguished! This means no walking away to let the fire smoulder until it's out.**

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

***\*\*\*Please note that Open Burns are permitted but Category 3 fires are prohibited.\*\*\****

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).
