**Bylaw No 542 - Prohibit Feeding of Deer** - At the July 18 Regular Meeting, Council passed a bylaw to prohibit the feeding of deer within the boundaries of The Village of Midway. Section 2 and 3 of the bylaw reads:

# 2. Prohibition

2.1 No person shall feed deer or cause deer to be fed.2.2 No person shall permit deer to be fed on property he or she occupies as a permanent or semi-permanent place of residence.

# 3. Offence

3.1 Every person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw, or who suffers or permits any act or thing to be done in contravention or in violation of any provision of this Bylaw or who neglects to do or refrains from doing anything required to be done by any provision of this Bylaw, commits an offence and, upon conviction, shall be liable to a maximum fine of up to \$500.00

**Burning Ban** - Effective July 26, 2022, no person shall light or start, or knowingly permit or cause to start or ignite any fire in the open air. (Village of Midway Bylaw 451).

The use of approved portable (propane) campfire apparatus may be used as long as no solid fuels are added for the purposes of heating, cooking and ceremonial purposes and the flame must not exceed 0.5 metres in height and width.
