The Village of Midway Office offers all of your ICBC Autoplan and Drivers Services needs. **2022 Municipal Elections** - The election for the office of Mayor and Council for Midway will be held October 15, 2022 from 8am to 8pm at the Village Office. Advance voting will be held October 5, 2022, 8am to 8pm in the municipal office Council Chambers at 661 Eighth Ave. Registration will be completed at the time of voting. Remember to bring two pieces of ID. You must be a resident of Midway or own property in Midway to be eligible to vote.

Burning Ban - Despite the Southeast Fire Centre lifting their prohibition on campfires, our Fire Chief has made the cautious decision to keep the campfire ban in place within the boundaries of the Village of Midway. He will be reevaluating the current conditions as well as the long term forecast on a daily basis. We will post on our website and social media accounts when campfires are again permitted in Midway.

The use of approved portable (propane) campfire apparatus may be used as long as no solid fuels are added for the purposes of heating, cooking and ceremonial purposes and the flame must not exceed 0.5 metres in height and width.


