APPOINTMENT TO MIDWAY'S BOARD OF VARIANCE

The Village of Midway is accepting applications from interested residents wishing to serve on the Midway Board of Variance.

The Municipal Council will be appointing three members effective January 2023 for a three-year term, ending in December 2025.

The Board of Variance is an independent body with the power to vary zoning bylaw regulations in situations where compliance with respect to the siting, dimension or size of a building or structure would cause a person undue hardship. The Board of Variance may not vary the density or use of the land.

The three-member volunteer Board meets when applications for variance are received. All meetings are open to the public and involve the weighing of information and evidence to determine if variances are to be approved or declined.
