**2023 Business Licences** - The \$50 annual fee is due in January for businesses operating in the Village of Midway. Fees can be paid at the Village Office.

**Dog Tags** - 2023 dog tags are now available at the Village Office. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Cash & cheque until 2023 then we can accept debit in January.

**Fire Permits** - Residents are reminded that burning permits are required for <u>all fires</u> within the Village of Midway and can be purchased for \$1 at the Village Office.

Fire permits are valid for the calendar year, please visit the Village Office for your 2023 permit.

Camp fires must be supervised until it is completely extinguished! This means no walking away to let the fire smoulder until it's out.

No person shall ignite or cause to be ignited any household waste, refuse, rubbish, garbage, plastic, or styrofoam, industrial or commercial waste. The office door is still closed to the public but window service is available.

### \*\*\*Please note that Open Burns are permitted but Category 3 fires are prohibited.\*\*\*

Any person who contravenes or violates any provision of this Bylaw could be liable to a minimum fine of \$500.00 and should the Midway Volunteer Fire Department/Emergency Responder be required, the Permittee shall be liable for the total cost of the fire call per Bylaw #451, Part 10, Sec. 51 (2) (3).

A public library association must have at least 5 trustees

### **Key Duties**

- Setting the strategic direction and goals of the library
- · Determining policy
- Hiring, evaluating and supporting the Library Director
- Reviewing the annual operating budget and monitoring revenue and expenditures through the year
- Conducting public relations and fundraising initiatives

#### Commitment

- Trustees serve for a two year term
- Trustees may serve up to four consecutive two year terms
- Meetings are held six times per year
- Additional time may be required for committee work and fundraising activity

### Requirements

- A belief in the importance of Libraries and a willingness to learn and participate in governance.
- Experience in business or not for profit organizations is helpful but not necessary. There are workshops, information sharing sessions and access to individual supports through the B.C. Library Trustees Association and the Kootenay Library Federation
