Water Restrictions - The Province of BC is experiencing drought conditions that are earlier and more widespread than usual. As a result a voluntary reduction in water use is in place. Please ensure that you water responsibly. This includes **no watering between the hours of 10 am and 6 pm** as well as ensuring that the water is not going into areas that do not require it (like the road and driveways). Thank you for doing your part. If you are on your own well, please remember that we all draw from the same aquifer and **individual wells will typically run dry before municipal wells**. It is in everyone's best interest to be water conscious during the hot summer months.

Burning Ban - Effective July 10, 2023, no person shall light or start, or knowingly permit or cause to start or ignite any fire in the open air. (Village of Midway Bylaw 451).

Due to the expected heat wave and dry conditions there is the potential for rapid fire spread should ignition occur. For this reason campfires and open air burning of solid fuels are not permitted.



The use of approved portable (propane) campfire apparatus may be used as long as no solid fuels are added for the purposes of heating, cooking and ceremonial purposes and the flame must not exceed 0.5 metres in height and width.
