**Utility Billing** - The 2024 Water and Sewer Utility billing have been mailed. Please remember, like property taxes, these are not due until July 2, 2024. After that, a 10% penalty will be applied to any unpaid balance. Everyone is welcome to pay at their convenience to avoid having to pay both at the same time. Property Tax notices will be issued in May.

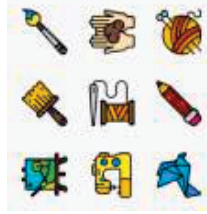
