The Village of Midway Office offers all of your ICBC Autoplan and Drivers Services needs.

Tree Recycling Facility

Has reopened for the 2024 season.

The only materials allowed at this site are **branches or bushes that have been pruned with a diameter of 6" or less.**

Property Taxes - The deadline for paying taxes and utility fees is **Tuesday July 2, 2024 at 4:30pm.** Any outstanding amounts after that date will incur a 10% penalty. The Village can accept cash, cheque or debit (no credit cards) as payment. Post-dated cheques to July 2, 2024 are accepted but post-marks will not be accepted. Please remember that if you haven't paid for your Water and Sewer utilities that they are also due by July 2, 2024. If you are new to Midway, please contact the office to make sure we have your current mailing address.

There are a number of homeowner grants still not claimed. Please ensure you claim your grant before the July 2 deadline. The 10% penalty will be applied to the current outstanding amount, including the amount you could have saved by claiming your grant. Even if you have a mortgage, you still need to claim the grant. If you can't pay the full amount by July 2, claim the grant so it reduces the 10% penalty.

Spray Park - Staff are working hard to get the Spray Park up and running and are hopeful that it will be fully functional on Canada Day. Pack a towel and change of clothes to the park on July 1st just in case!

2023 Annual Municipal Report - Section 98 of the Community Charter sets out the requirements for municipalities to produce an Annual Report each year prior to June 30th. The report must contain: Audited financial statements, Report on permissive tax exemptions, Report on municipal services and operations for the previous year, and Statement of objectives and measures for the current and next year. Firearms Bylaw - Residents are reminded of the firearms restrictions in areas within the boundaries of the Village of Midway. Bylaw 207, Section 5 states: No person shall discharge a firearm within or into those areas shown as closed to the discharge of firearms in Schedule "A" attached hereto, except as otherwise provided in this By-law." Please note that Bylaw 462 amends Bylaw 207. For more information regarding these restricted areas refer to Schedule A map of Bylaw 462 which can be found on our website:

Water Restrictions - Residents are reminded that watering restrictions are always in effect per Bylaw No. 413 and that sprinkling (irrigating) lawns and gardens between the hours of 10:00 am and 6:00 pm is prohibited. On your own well? Remember that all Village water comes from the same aquifer and your use also contributes to the lower water levels.
