Subject: 2024-2028 Five-Year Financial Plan Amendment

The Village of Midway 2024 – 2028 Five-Year Financial Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 571, 2024”, amending The Village of Midway 2024 – 2028 Five-Year Financial Plan Bylaw No. 562, 2024.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council receives the attached report for consideration.

ISSUE/PURPOSE:

To seek approval from Council for “The Village of Midway 2024 – 2028 Five-Year Financial Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 571, 2024”, amending The Village of Midway 2024 – 2028 Five-Year Financial Plan Bylaw No. 562, 2024.

BACKGROUND:

At the Special Council meeting on May 15th, 2024, Council approved Bylaw No. 562, 2024.2024 – 2028 Five Year Financial Plan. During Budget deliberations, the Community Hall project was still in the planning stages and the construction phase of the project was forecast in budget years 2024 and 2025. Unfortunately, due to the project going out for bid twice in 2024, the construction phase of the project has been delayed. To take into account this change, which is a significant decrease to the 2024 budget, staff have amended Schedule “A” - Operating Fund and General Capital Expenditures and Funding Sources.

FINANCIAL/BUDGETARY IMPLICATIONS:

The forecasted spend has been moved to 2025, when the main construction of the project will take place. Funding sources related to the project have been adjusted accordingly. The Budget amendment will ensure a more accurate actual versus budget comparison.

GOVERNANCE CONSIDERATIONS:

Community Charter Part 6 Financial Management

165 (1) A municipality must have a financial plan that is adopted annually, by bylaw, before the annual property tax bylaw is adopted.

(2) For certainty, the financial plan may be amended by bylaw at any time.

(3) The planning period for a financial plan is 5 years, that period being the year in which the plan is specified to come into force and the following 4 years.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council approves for the June 30th meeting to be cancelled, and for the 2025 Regular Council meeting schedule to be approved as amended.

ISSUE/PURPOSE:

To seek approval from Council for an amendment to the 2025 Regular Council meeting dates.

BACKGROUND:

At the Regular Council meeting on November 12, 2024, Council approved the 2025 Regular Council Meeting Schedule, after reviewing two options. Prior to advertising for the 2025 schedule, staff discovered that the June 30th meeting was not cancelled. This time is particularly busy at the Village office with the lead up to final tax payments and the Canada Day festivities. Staff are asking for Council approval to cancel the June 30th meeting from the schedule. The number of meetings scheduled for the year will be amended to 15 meetings. Staff do not expect this change to impact the flow or timing of correspondence being provided to Council for review, and there is the option to schedule a Special meeting if needed. As previously mentioned on the November 12th, 2024 report, in 2024 the Village of Midway had 11 special Council meetings, these included meetings for annual Budget deliberations, auditor presentation on the 2024 Financial Statements and Community Hall upgrade discussions. In 2023 and 2022, 16 special meetings were held. In 2021, 7 special meetings were held, and in 2020 10 special meetings were held.

COMMUNICATION:

There is still time to make the change prior to advertising the 2025 meeting schedule. The Public Notice will be displayed on the Village Notice Boards, Village website and newsletter and in the Grand Forks Gazette for two editions.

GOVERNANCE CONSIDERATIONS:

In accordance with section 127 of the Community Charter, the Council must prepare annually on or before December 31st, a schedule of the dates, times and places of regular Council meetings and must make the schedule available to the public by posting it at the Public Notice Posting Place.
