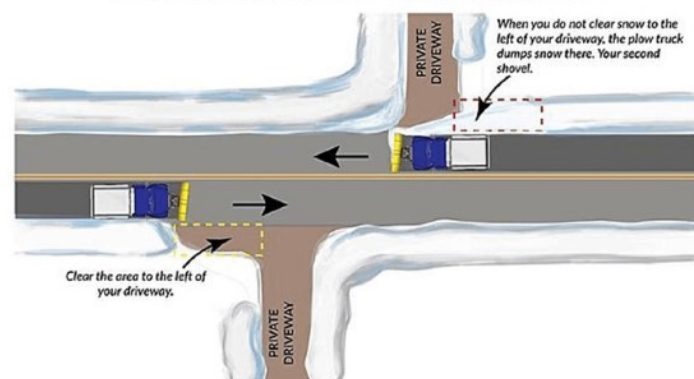

**Responsible Pet Owners** - Cat owners are reminded that as per Bylaw 438 Part 6: “The Owner of a Dog, Cat or Animal must not allow or permit the Dog, Cat or Animal to be At Large in the Village.” As well as Part 7: “The Owner of a Dog, Cat or Animal must not allow or permit the Dog, Cat or Animal to leave or deposit excrement on any public place or on private property other than the property of the Owner, unless the Owner immediately takes steps to remove such excrement and to dispose of it in a sanitary manner.” There have been some concerns about cats freely roaming the Village. Cats are much harder to contain than dogs, but the owner is still responsible for their cat’s actions.



**Airport Hangar Space Rentals** - Space in the airport hangar is available to rent for vehicles/ trailers/RVS. For trailers this includes the length of the trailer plus the length of the hitch. Rental space is available on a first-come first-served basis. Please call the Village Office for more information on rental rates and availability at 250-449-2222. Renters are required to have a minimum of \$2 million liability insurance on the unit.

**Plowing and Boulevards** - Residents are reminded to keep all boulevards clear of vehicles and other obstructions to ensure Public Works can effectively remove snow in a timely matter. This includes rocks and other objects that can freeze to the ground potentially causing damage to Municipal equipment.
