Midway Community Centre Project Update – January 2025

- Site demolition has begun, and will be continuing into February
- The interior plumbing upgrades are in the planning stages
- The new elevator has been ordered and is in the production queue
- The building upgrades include energy efficiency upgrades, wheelchair accessibility upgrades, a new covered ramp, elevator, new washrooms, kitchen and bar. The upgrades and retrofit are expected to increase the use and comfort of the facility, as well as making it more accessible.
