Update on the Kettle Valley Trail Clean-up -

An article entitled "Tires Hit the Road" was recently published in the Kettle River Echo community newsletter, detailing the cleanup efforts along the Kettle Valley Trail in

Midway. Trails to the Boundary successfully secured a grant from the Trans Canada Trail Society (TCT) to support a project dedicated to removing a significant number of tires that had accumulated over the years—one even dated back to 1965! The Village of Midway extends its gratitude to Trails to the Boundary Society and project leader Barry Rathburn, and collaborating organizations including Tire



Stewardship BC, Pourboys and Liberty Tire for their contributions to this project. Although initial concerns were raised regarding the feasibility of removing all tires given their size and associated costs, residents in the Boundary community rallied together to ensure the successful removal of the remaining tires. The Village of Midway thanks those individuals for their exemplary commitment. The spirit of cooperation and community engagement demonstrated in this area remains commendable. The next step in the clean-up involves levelling soil, planting grass seed, and installing signage to prevent future dumping.


