**2026 Business Licences** - The \$50 annual fee is due in January for businesses operating in the Village of Midway. Fees can be paid at the Village Office in the new year.

**Fire Permits** - Residents are reminded that fire permits are valid only for the calendar year. Permits will need to be renewed in January for 2026.

### **Slippery roads, parking lots, and sidewalks -**

**Dog Tags** - 2026 dog tags are now available at the Village Office if you would like to pay using cash or post dated cheque. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered. Debit can be accepted in 2026.
