Budget Planning 2026 - Each year, the Village develops an annual budget to meet community needs and balance the delivery of services with property taxes and user fees. The Village is committed to financial transparency and strong fiscal management which form a foundation of the budget process. The budget is developed to manage current demands but also incorporates the longer-term strategy and vision for the Village through its Financial Plan. The Council of the Village of Midway will be considering the draft 2026-2030 Financial Plan over the next couple of months. Special budget meeting dates will be advertised in the Village newsletter and on the Village website. If you would like an item to be considered by Council during Budget deliberations, please send your request to midwayreception@shaw.ca, or drop off your request to the Village office.

Accessibility Advisory Committee - The Village of Midway is currently seeking applicants to fill vacancies on its Accessibility Advisory Committee. Individuals with disabilities, as well as representatives of organizations that serve people with disabilities, are encouraged to apply. The Committee requires that at least 50% of its members be persons with disabilities.

The Committee's mandate is to support the Village in identifying barriers impacting individuals within the community and to provide recommendations for their removal and prevention.

The Committee convenes two to three times per year and works on establishing priorities for Council's consideration. Members serve on a volunteer basis and do not receive compensation for their services.

Appointments to the Accessibility Advisory Committee are made by Council and will align with the current Council term.
