Midway Partnership Fund - Will be accepting Letters of Intent for 2026 grant funding until April 30, 2026 at 4pm. Application forms can be picked up from the Village Office. Grant proposals must focus on ideas within the geographical area of the Village of Midway. The partnership will consider a wide range of creative projects designed for the benefit of a maximum number of people in the Midway area. Funded activities that take an innovated approach to community concerns or provide a direct service to the community of Midway are preferred.

Applications for these funds are reviewed in the spring of each year by the Midway Partnership Fund Directors.

Midway Public Library AGM - Join the Midway Public Library for their AGM on Monday March 23 @ 6pm. New board members are welcome so if you are interested please attend the AGM and see what the library has planned for 2026!

Tree Recycling Facility - Has reopened for the 2026 season. You can pay the \$10 fee at the Village Office when you pick up a key. Keys will need to be returned to the Office once you are done with it. If you are dumping branches or bushes please make sure that they have been pruned to a **diameter of 6" or less**. If you have grass clippings or easily compostable waste, it can be dropped off at the Community Garden compost pile, next to the Airport Hangars. However, please do not leave your branches, etc at the Community Garden, non-compostable material is not welcome there.

2026 Business Licences - The \$50 annual fee was due in January for businesses operating in the Village of Midway. Fees can be paid at the Village Office using cash, cheque or debit.

Dog Tags - 2026 dog tags are available at the Village Office. Accepted method of payments are cash, cheque or debit. \$15 for spayed or neutered, or \$30 for un-spayed or un-neutered.
