Midway Partnership Fund - Will be accepting Letters of Intent for 2026 grant funding until April 30, 2026 at 4pm. Application forms can be picked up from the Village Office. Grant proposals must focus on ideas within the geographical area of the Village of Midway. The partnership will consider a wide range of creative projects designed for the benefit of a maximum number of people in the Midway area. Funded activities that take an innovated approach to community concerns or provide a direct service to the community of Midway are preferred. Applications for these funds are reviewed in the spring of each year by the Midway Partnership Fund Directors.

Responsible Pet Owners - Pet owners are reminded that Bylaw 438 Part 8 & 9 states:

- 8) The Owner of a Dog, Cat or Animal must not allow or permit the Dog, Cat or Animal by its barks, cries, or other noises to disturb the quiet, peace, rest, enjoyment, comfort, or convenience of persons at two or more residences in the vicinity of where the Dog or Animal is kept.
- 9) The Owner of a Dog, Cat or Animal must not allow or permit the Dog, Cat or animal to call, cry or bark, continuously or sporadically for 15 minutes or more, in such a way that the noise is audible outside the parcel where the Dog, Cat or animal is kept, as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer believes such noise is objectionable and liable to disturb the peace, rest, enjoyment, comfort or convenience, of individuals or the public.
