### Tree Recycling Facility

**Has reopened for the 2026 season.**

**Branches or bushes that have been pruned must have a diameter of 6" or less.**

**2026 Property Taxes** - The deadline for paying taxes and utility fees is **Thursday July 2, 2026 at 4:30pm**. Any outstanding amounts after that date will incur a 10% penalty. The Village can accept cash, cheque, e-transfer (send to: **midwayfinance@shaw.ca**) or debit (no credit cards) and as payment. Post-dated cheques to July 2, 2026 are accepted but post-marks will not be accepted. Please remember that if you haven't paid for your Water and Sewer utilities that they are also due by July 2, 2026. If you are new to Midway, please contact the office to make sure we have your current mailing address.

**There are a number of homeowner grants still not claimed. Please ensure you claim your grant before the July 2 deadline. The 10% penalty will be applied to the current outstanding amount, including the amount you could have saved by claiming your grant. Even if you have a mortgage, you still need to claim the grant. If you can't pay the full amount by July 2, claim the grant so it reduces the 10% penalty.**

**Water Restrictions** - Public Works has already noticed a large increase in water usage since the brief warm spell at the start of May. Please remember that watering restrictions are always in effect per Bylaw No. 413 and that sprinkling (irrigating) lawns and gardens between the hours of 10:00 am and 6:00 pm is prohibited. Are you on your own well? All Village water comes from the same aquifer and your use contributes to lower water levels. We are expecting a hot summer and the river is below the levels we have been seeing the last couple of years. *Further water restrictions should be expected this summer.*
